Early Decision Plan

The Early Decision Plan is ideal for students who have already decided to attend West Virginia Wesleyan College.

The following are some of the advantages of the plan:

- Notification of your admission decision within three weeks of the receipt of the completed admission file, beginning October 1.
- An estimated financial aid award before January 31.
- Early class registration.
- Priority status for residence hall room selection.

Early Decision applications for first-time freshmen may be submitted any time after the end of your junior year, but must be received by the Office of Admission before December 1. A completed file includes an application, official high school transcript, SAT or ACT scores, and the High School Academic Request Form.

The Early Decision Agreement is required of all students applying under the Early Decision Plan. This is a binding agreement that states you will enroll at West Virginia Wesleyan College if you are accepted. Early Decision students who are accepted agree to withdraw applications from all other colleges and submit a nonrefundable \$200 deposit to Wesleyan by January 31.
