Essay	All programs require an essay. See Graduate Essay Form (page 15). Your essay will be evaluated on the quality of your writing as well as your response.
Required Letters of Reference	For All Programs: Two letters of reference must be written by academic or professional references. Letters from family/friends will not be accepted.
Required Standardized Test Scores	Communication Sciences and Disorders (M.S.): GRE required Doctorate in Audiology (Au.D.): GRE required
Application Deadlines	Communication Sciences and Disorders (M.S.): February 15 (fall) Doctorate in Audiology (Au.D.): February 1 (fall) All other programs: Rolling admissions. Students whose applications are complete at least one month prior to the semester are guaranteed decisions for the semester. Applications completed thereafter will be considered on a rolling basis.
Additional Application Instructions	All Programs: Please attach a current résumé. Educational Leadership: Submit a verification letter signed by a designated school/district official attesting to three years of full-time K–12 teaching experience or school pupil personnel service in a student service profession. Literacy: Valid New York State teaching certification is required for entry. Communication Sciences and Disorders (M.S.):* Communication Sciences and Disorders (D.A.):* Candidate interview required.
