## **Applying for Academic Scholarships Only**

If you are applying **only** for Academic Scholarships you must complete the Application for Scholarships and Financial Aid. This form is included in the Admissions Application booklet.

## **Applying for All Forms of Assistance**

If you are an **Early Decision** applicant and wish to apply for all forms of assistance, you should complete the Application for Scholarships and Financial Aid and the CSS Profile form. Return the Application for Scholarships and Financial Aid to the Office of Financial Aid postmarked no later than **November 15, 2005**. Have the CSS Profile (http://profileonline.collegeboard.com) sent to Furman, (Code number for Furman is 5222.) You must complete and submit the FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID (FAFSA) as soon as possible after **January 2, 2006**, to confirm estimated federal, state and institutional need-based assistance.

If you are a **Regular Decision or Transfer** candidate and wish to apply for all forms of assistance, you should complete the Application for Scholarships and Financial Aid and the FAFSA. The priority deadline to submit these forms is **February 15**.

Transfer candidates please note that final college transcript(s) must be received before state and some types of federal aid can be determined.
