general information

The Bureau of Citizenshi and Immigration Services of the U.S. government requires Saint Mary's College to verify the financial resources of all foreign applicants. This form is for that purpose. It is important that you complete it carefully.

You will see that the estimated total costs for the academic year, September 1 through May 30, are listed below for Saint Mary's College. You are required to certify that you will have the amount shown. The amount does NOT include estimated living expenses for the summer vacation period, or for your transportation costs to the College.

You must indicate how you will pay your expenses during each year of study. You should assume that expenses will rise about 10% for each year of study.

Please remember that student visa holders will not be authorized to work in the U.S. except under special circumstances. You should not plan on employment to provide for your support while a student here.

When you request your visa from the U.S. consular officials, you will be required to prove that you have sufficient funds to study at Saint Mary's College. We suggest, therefore, that you make copies of this form and the related documents for that purpose. Listed below are the steps to follow in completing this form.

steps to complete this form

- 1. find the total estimated yearly costs for saint mary's college.
- 2. estimate the amount of time needed to complete your program.
- 3. enter the estimated costs in the appropriate lines in section a on the reverse side of this form. add 10% for each year of expected study.
- 4. complete and sign section b on the reverse side of this application.
- 5. complete sections c and d on the reverse and obtain signatures and supporting evidence from the sponsor and of the bank official in those sections.

fees due

Fifty percent of the yearly tuition and room and board fees are due on registration day of the fall term and the second fifty percent at spring registration. Students may not register for classes until these charges are paid in full. A monthly payment plan is also available upon request.

The College cannot send you forms for your student visa until complete financial certification has been obtained. Be sure to have appropriate signatures in Sections B, C, and D on the reverse side of this form.
