Please be as candid as possible, since it is often impossible for AUC to interview all potential graduate students. Your evaluation of the student's academic performance, research capabilities and overall ability at the graduate level based on past performance is a critical element of our selection process. It would also be very helpful if you could rank the candidate in terms of all the students you have had in the past. This evaluation is to be given to the applicant in a sealed and signed envelope.
