Instructions for Applying to the Arabic Language Intensive Program

You must complete and submit the following documents to be considered for admission.

- 1. One letter of recommendation (company-sponsored applicants exempted)
- 2. If you are currently enrolled in a university, you must submit an official university transcript
- 3. Copy of passport
- 4. Two recent photos
- 5. Please submit your application and all supporting documentation to the Office of Enrollment, Admission and Student Service Center

Note: No application fee is required.

No academic transcripts are required except if you are currently enrolled in a university. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

You must submit the following to the University before you can register:

- 1. Results of a recent comprehensive medical examination by a physician if you have a chronic illness
- 2. Recent HIV antibodies test results (non-Egyptians only)
- 3. \$2,000 deposit per semester. This amount will be held until the end of the semester against withdrawal from the program and unpaid charges that may remain on the student's account

Visas

To enter Egypt, you must obtain a tourist entry visa from the Egyptian government. These may be obtained at any Egyptian embassy or consulate in your home country. After arriving in Cairo and registering at AUC for full-time enrollment, international students will apply for a student residence visa. This second visa requires a study approval by the Egyptian government that can take four to six weeks. To speed up the process, we ask you to submit the International Student Data Form and a photocopy of your passport information page at the time you apply for admission.
