

GRADUATE RECORD EXAMINATION (GRE)

Applicants to the master's program must take the GRE. It takes 4-6 weeks for the scores to reach us. Without the GRE scores, your application will be incomplete.

Applicants are expected to have at least a 500 score on the Verbal section, and 4.5 score on the Analytical Writing section. See registration procedures below.

Computer-Based Testing Dates: The computer-adaptive General Test is offered at many locations around the world on the following schedule:
February - August-- First 3 weeks of the month

You may take the CBT once per calendar month. This is true even if you canceled your scores on a previous CBT taken within the same month.

The computer-based test can be taken in Topeka, Wichita, or Gladstone, MO, at Sylvan Technology Centers.

The cost for the computer based exams is \$115.

There is **NO Late Registration Service**.

Standby registration service adds \$35 to the test fee. It is possible only if sufficient space, materials and staff are available after all registered test takers have been admitted. You must take with you a completed registration form, fee, 2" x 2" recent photo of yourself for the photo file record, and a photo identification as described in the Information Bulletin.
