

# URSINUS

Historically, students who apply early decision are accepted at a higher rate than students who apply regular decision. Here's why:

- You compete only against yourself rather than against other well-qualified applicants who apply regular decision.
- You send a clear signal to the Admissions Committee that Ursinus is your first-choice college, a factor that may improve your chances of acceptance.

Why early decision?

Early decision is the process by which the college evaluates the credentials of a student for whom Ursinus is the first choice and who wishes to receive early notification of his or her admission status. If you are accepted, you agree to do the following:

- Enroll at Ursinus
- Withdraw any applications you have submitted to other colleges

If you answer yes to all of the following questions then you should seriously consider applying early decision.

- Did I visit the Ursinus campus?
- When I visited did I discover that Ursinus has the academic program that is right for me?
- When I visited did I discover that I would enjoy spending four years with the students I met?
- Is Ursinus my first-choice college?
